PROCEDURE

STEP 1 Remove the two 1/4-20 screws holding the clamp halves together; set them aside for now, they will be reused.

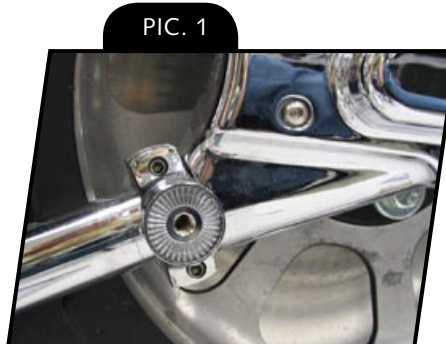
STEP 2 Position the rear half of the clamp on the inside of the swingarm (PIC 1) secure the front half to the rear using the 1/4-20 screws removed in Step 1.

STEP 3 Attach the License Plate Mount (sold separately) to the Swingarm clamp using the supplied 5/16-18 SHCS.

STEP 4 Adjust the plate to desired position and tighten all fasteners.

CAUTION! Be sure there is adequate clearance between the clamp and the pulley

ATTENTION! It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that all of the fasteners (including pre-assembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Kuryakyn will not issue a warranty on components lost due to improper installation. Periodic maintenance may be required.
