Installation

1. Remove the stock cover from the bike.
2. Un-wrap the new cover, turn over and install the Included black wedge installation clips onto the 3 mounting tabs. See stock cover for reference if needed.
3. If a badge or LED lighting is to be installed on cover, install before mounting new cover on bike.
4. Once clips and badge (if applicable) is secured, mount the cover to bike by aligning the clip tabs and pushing into place.

Warning: Follow smart safety practices while installing this product. Make sure the bike is parked on level ground and is cool before beginning installation.

Note: The cover can be used on the Left or Right side of the bike. We recommend a badge to cover the key hole for the right side application. Badges (sold separately) are available from Custom Dynamics®, see our website or call for details.
